

I can not begin to thank you enough for sharing your gifts and skills with the Neural Organizational Work with my son Rhett. I feel like we have been given a new ray of hope for his life's unfoldment and for those of us who love him so dearly, we are grateful. I'd like to share with you in summary what we have experienced since the treatment you gave him on Sept. 30.

My son Rhett is an 11 year old boy who HAD the following symptoms going into the treatment on that Sunday afternoon:

- walks on toes
- has never spoken
- makes auditory sounds, lot of whining
- wears diapers
- constipation, can't move bowels on own
- no eye contact more than a few seconds
- doesn't like looking in mirrors
- fidgety
- stiff neck
- smiles occasionally
- doesn't like to be watched
- cries for several hours before bed
- tosses in bed a lot

Noticeable changes within first three hours after treatment:

- walking flat footed much of the time on right foot, part the time on left
- eye contact for 5-7 seconds (even with strangers)
- moving head side to side fluidly
- looking in mirror and not crying
- calmed down to peaceful state in about two hours, very little fidgeting with hands
- happy face with smiling here and there
- showing physical huggy, loving contact with newly met people
- no whining
- heavy sinus drainage

On the way home from Salt Lake, we stopped in Vernal and there was a lady sitting at the park, he watched her and when she spoke to him, he went over and sat by her and a few minutes later, he tried to hug her.

Additional noticeable changes within two weeks:

- teacher noticed in first day the differences. Said his face is bright and happy and she noticed his flat foot walking immediately.
- first time to climb on to playground equipment with no help
- able to move bowels without enema
- stopped crying before bed
- Note: when walking now with flat feet, bumps and stubs toes because he doesn't know the length of his feet. Have to keep shoes on him.
- Uncle says " can't believe his face, it's so different with a peaceful look now"
- able to access his arm pits for cleaning, etc. without resistance and struggle (biggy)
- will let mom watch him now while playing
- moves normal at night

If I were to give you one feeling I am experiencing it would be that I am "EXCITED." I really believe that with this application of the N.O.W. that a true turning point has occurred for my son Rhett's recovery
